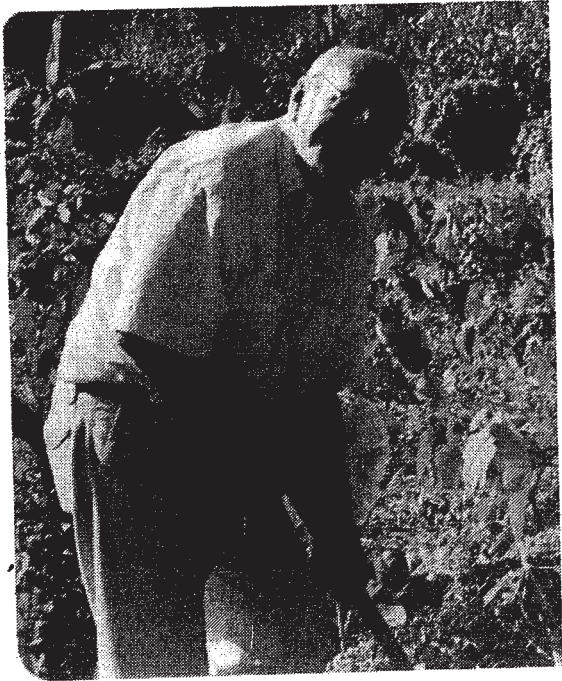
Beqa Island brought us many special relationships - especially with all of the beautiful children.

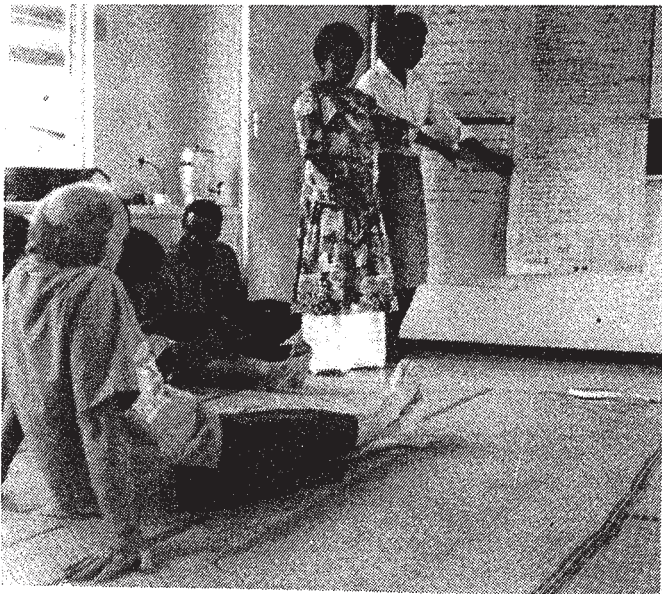
